CHAIRMANS REPORT 2011/2012

This year has been relatively quiet compared to previous years.

The Wainhomes Development is certainly progressing and it's nice to see that a number of local people that managed to move into the new development and I also welcome any new parishioners into our parish.

The Truthan Wind farm application was resubmitted minus the two turbines to the east of the A39. The application is due to be heard by a Public Inquiry in June, at the St Erme Community Centre and is expected to last between 6-8 days.

We completed our Emergency Plan & I would like to thank all the volunteers who came forward with offers of help and who have been put on our database.

We gave out £4,737.00 in grants this year to help local organisations carry out the good work, which they do with in our community.

Last year saw the new Community Centre open of which the parish council contributed a grant of £80,000, to help finish the project. This facility is well used by parishioners and has brought some new groups and businesses into the parish.

The parish council has placed a Granite Plaque outside the Community Centre to commemorate winning National Council in 2010. This was following consultation with parishioners. The granites originally formed part of the bridge at Truthan dating back to the middle ages. They were removed when the bridge was strengthened several years ago. The parish council managed to retain 3 of the granites.

Following the Parish Plan carried out in 2004, the last remaining item left is the Cycle Path to Truro. We have not had any help in this from Cornwall Council, but hopefully in the future we will be able to achieve this.

We have now started our St Erme Village Design Statement and hope to get this completed over the next few months. Please look out and respond to the next consultation events that will be taking place during this time.
