Truro & Roseland Community Network Area Highways Schemes

Under this scheme a Feasibility Study has been carried out in St Erme to consider reducing the speed limit in the village from 30mph to 20mph. Various options have been considered and a 'Expression of Interest' will be put forward for the project to be considered for next year.

We will keep you updated once we know if our scheme has been accepted.

EGLOS ROAD WALL

We have received a number of telephone calls and e-mails about the damaged wall at Eglos Road which backs onto the Tren creek Close car park.

This is a difficult situation as a Parish Council or Cornwall Council we are unable to use public money to reinstate the wall as it is not owned or managed by us; we are governed by law on what we as a council can contribute too.

We are in the process of trying to establish who is responsible for the wall in question. Unfortunately it seems that this will not be a simple process but we are keen to get the wall re-instated. We are doing everything within our power to get this issue sorted and are still working on a solution.

Unfortunately it may take some time.
