A39 TRISPEN ROAD RENEWAL

Works are progressing well, and Cormac currently anticipate (weather depending) completing the section of works from the Trispen North Junction to Carland Cross by 18th December.

When they return on 4th January 2016 they shall still require the same road closure arrangement as was currently in place for an additional week.

From the 10/11th January 2016 they shall be closing the section between Trispen North and Trispen South only, with access to the village from both Buckshead and Carland Cross. The works period for this section shall be 4 weeks, following that they shall progress into the narrow section.

ST ERME EMERGENCY PLAN

About the 'St Erme Emergency Plan'

St Erme Parish Council and members of the community work together to be better prepared with dealing with emergencies such as snow, major fire, or any other incidences that could have an effect on the community.

We were first approached by Cornwall Council in 2010 to pilot this project and were the first community to have completed and tested a Community Emergency Plan.

Committee

A committee was formed consisting of members of St Erme Parish Council and members of the community, who are the coordinators of the plan.

We now have a list of 70 volunteers and wardens with different skills which could assist in an incident.

We meet every six months to review the plan and update any necessary changes.

We are now looking at providing a quarterly newsletter to all the volunteers to keep everyone up to date.

At our last meeting we discussed working with our neighbouring parishes of Ladock, St Newlyn East, Probus, St Allen and St Clement some of whom have their own plans or are now working towards one.

We feel that it would be good to liaise with each other and have the contacts to assist each other, and to share experiences and knowledge.

There are currently grants available to claim from Cornwall Council up to the value of £500.00 towards Emergency Plans that are already up and running and it was agreed to ask the parish council to apply on our behalf towards general administration costs and publicity.

During this meeting we also discussed the possibility of a defibrillator for the parish and the possible funding that may be available. We are in discussions with the parish council and hopefully will be able to take this forward.

Within the plan we like to keep an up to date list of properties that use gas cylinder's etc. If you have gas cylinder's at your property please contact the clerk on the e-mail below so we can list these in the plan. This helps if there is a fire and we can highlight an area that may have gas cylinders in the proximity.
