

# St Erme Parish Church - St Hermes



The church is dedicated to a Greek who was said to be martyred in Rome in AD 132. It is medieval and grade 2 listed. It fell into disrepair in the 18th century but was extensively rebuilt in 1820 on the instruction of the Rector and further restoration took place in 1906 with the present bells being re-hung. The churchyard is still open and is well managed with the help of a grant from the Parish Council.

We are in a Benefice, together with Probus, Ladock, Grampound with Creed, Tresillian with Lamorran and St Michael Penkevil.

Our main worship is Eucharist, using Common Worship, at 9.30 am on Sundays, with a Family Service on the 1st Sunday together with Morning Prayer on the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday. We join other parishes in the Benefice on 5th Sundays.

There is a 1927 Hele & Co 2 manual organ with the work shared by 2 organists.  
The church is open daily, between 10.00am and 4.00 pm.
