

St Erme Village Hall Committee



The village hall has been an institution in the village since 1924 making it the third oldest, after the Church and Methodist Chapel. Housed in a building that started life as an auxiliary ward in Truro hospital (which came to be the isolation hospital) during the first world war.

It stands on a plot of land at the junction of School Lane and Church Road, (post code TR4 9BL), gifted to the hall, to serve the community. At first it was used as a reading room for soldiers returning from the war and subsequently developed into the community facility it is today.

The hall has recently undergone a complete refurbishment, to compliment the already refurbished toilets, with a completely replaced kitchen. Also the inside, outside and roof have been repaired and repainted, in readiness for the end of the Covid shut down.

The hall is used by a number of village groups including The Women's Institute, and The Silver Circle. Twinkle Totz and Messy Munchkins mother and toddler groups, and Lovemybody Club, a fitness and well being group.

It can also be hired by individuals and organisations for parties, Wakes, meetings etc.

The Hall is also the Parish Polling Station for all national and local elections.

Hiring is made per session,

Morning session	up till 13:00
Afternoon session	from 13:00 to 18:00
Evening session	From 18:00 to 23:59

The cost of any session is £7.00 for residents of the Parish.

The cost of any session is £14.00 for non residents.

This includes heating, electricity and use of the kitchen.

Crockery and cutlery can also be hired at a cost of £3.00 per hire.
