## Community Benefit Money Bids

Our public presentation event was held on Saturday 12th May 2018 at the St Erme Community Centre; each organisation gave a short presentation on their bids for the community benefits monies about their proposed project and how it will benefit the community. There were four bids in total.

We have decided that we can support all four bids within the available monies by reducing each bid value by approximately 5%.

The projects that will therefore be supported are as follows:

- **St Erme Village Hall** — monies towards the cost of new disabled access and doors into the hall via the fire exit
- **Trispen Methodist Church** — monies towards upgrading the lighting to more eco friendly lighting.
- **St Erme Parish Church** — monies towards the maintenance of the mature trees in the church yard and possible replanting schemes
- **St Erme Playing Field Trust** — monies towards the cost of purchasing the Cricket Field

We would like to thank everyone that attended the event, the organisations that put forward projects or held information stands and the members of the public .

## St Erme Emergency Plan and CPR / Defibrillator Training

The Emergency Plan Committee has undertaken to provide free CPR and defibrillator training for local residents. If you would like to attend a training session please contact the clerk on 07525130663 or at [clerk@stermeaparishcouncil.org.uk](mailto:clerk@stermeaparishcouncil.org.uk) to book a place. The courses are accredited by the British Heart Foundation and last approximately 1.5 hours.



The members of the community who attended the informal training last year found it very beneficial and were glad they attended.



We are looking at holding further courses during August this year, and we already have a number of people who have shown an interest, but we still have further spaces available

The defibrillators in the village are automated, anyone can use one, training is **not** necessary. The defibrillator will talk the user through how to use it and will **not** allow a shock to be given unless it detects that the heart is in a shockable rhythm. When dialling 999 the ambulance service will direct you to the nearest defibrillator in the parish.

There are two defibrillators in the parish one is located adjacent to Trispen Stores/Post Office and is maintained by the parish council.



The second one is located at the St Erme Community Centre at the Football/Cricket grounds. This one is a Fleet defibrillator and is overseen by the Community Centre in partnership with Fleet.



## Car Parking

We are regularly notified of inconsiderate parking in the village.

***One of the main concerns is cars being parked on the Emergency Access through Killigrew Gardens, this is classed as a footpath and not a road. It is therefore illegal to park at this location. Further action will be taken on this issue. Please do not park at this location it is for 'Emergency Vehicles' only.***

Other examples of inconsiderate parking are blocking or parking too close to garages and driveways, parking on grass verges or pavements or on junctions.

Please also remember that inconsiderate parking can also effect the emergency services attending incidents which could be life threatening. This could effect any one of us.
