This item was discussed and the comments made was that there is concern that the types of houses being built are not what is needed by communities, in relation to cost and affordability. Landowners are currently land banking to obtain the best prices, this needs to be addressed.

There are concerns at how the government can override Neighbourhood Plans by changing Policy.
